


NEWSLETTER #2

Ikaartuit documentary screening

This last fall the Ikaartuit documentary, made by Annie-Claude Roberge was launched in Kuujjuaq. Ikaartuit means: Caribous crossing the river, and can also symbolize getting through life's challenges by continuing the journey.

In the summer of 2022, eight teenagers and young adults from Kuujjuaq, Kangiqsualujjuaq and Kangirsuk took part in a two-week kayaking adventure. They paddled down part of the Koksoak River to Kuujjuaq, facing the challenges of the expedition.

Screenings were organized across Nunavik, in Kuujjuaq, Aupaluk, Kangirsuk, Salluit, Akulivik, Puvirnituq and Umiujaq. The documentary was also presented as part of the international conference Forest for Public Health and the Coexistence conference organized by Le Réseau. The documentary will soon be available online.
